43 proposals received

30 full papers were evaluated by a group of 51 experts, among them Fellow Reviewers from outstanding research centers around the world and by the members of our “Meeting Urban Food Needs” (MUFN) CFP1 –CFP3 Editorial Board

23 papers were accepted for Proceedings of the SYDIC and the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) “MUFN” project CFP1 and CFP3

16 papers were selected for presentation in the **First Mediterranean Conference on Food Supply and Distribution Systems in Urban Environment** the 6th and 7th of July, 2015 in Rome

11 papers of those 16 had strong recommendation to be published in a Special Issue on the International Journal *Agricultural Systems*, and **5** papers of those 16 had normal recommendation to be published in the Special Issue. The editorial board of the Journal reserves the right of rejection.

The authors of the best contributions will be invited to the **Expert seminar on the 8th of July**, 2015 in Rome.
